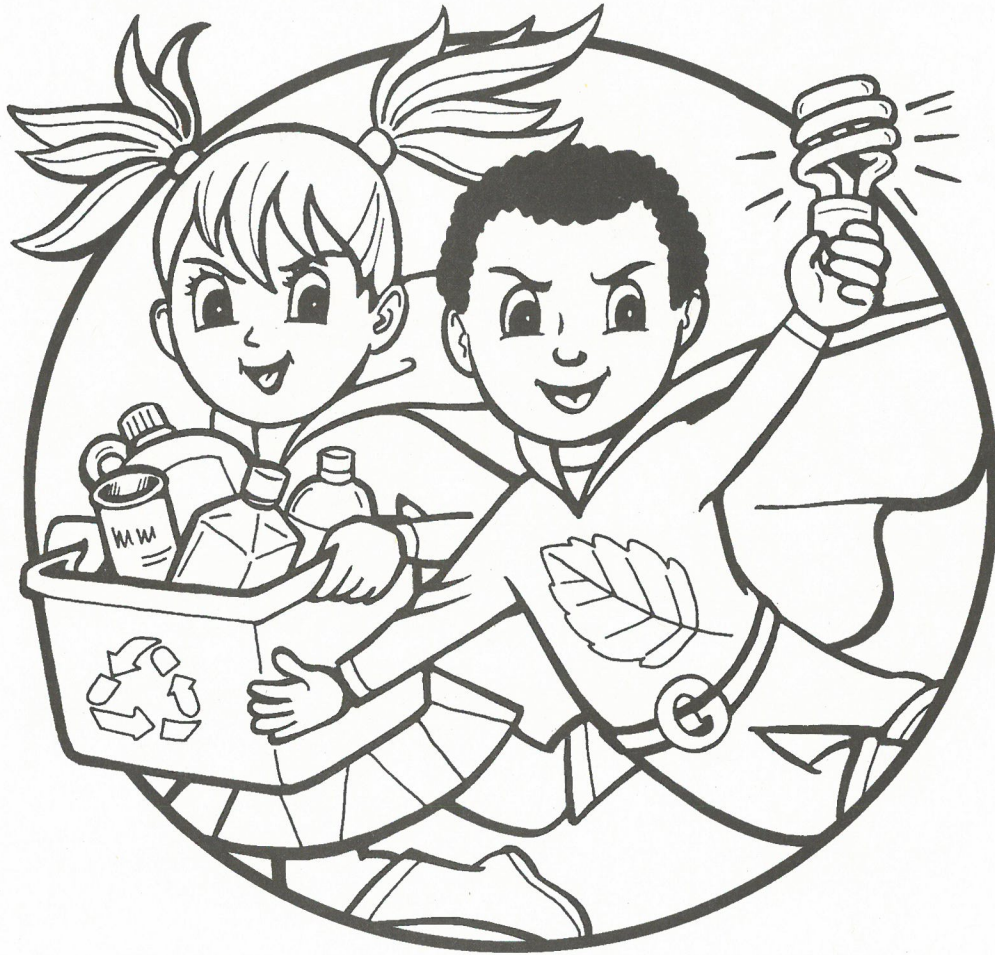

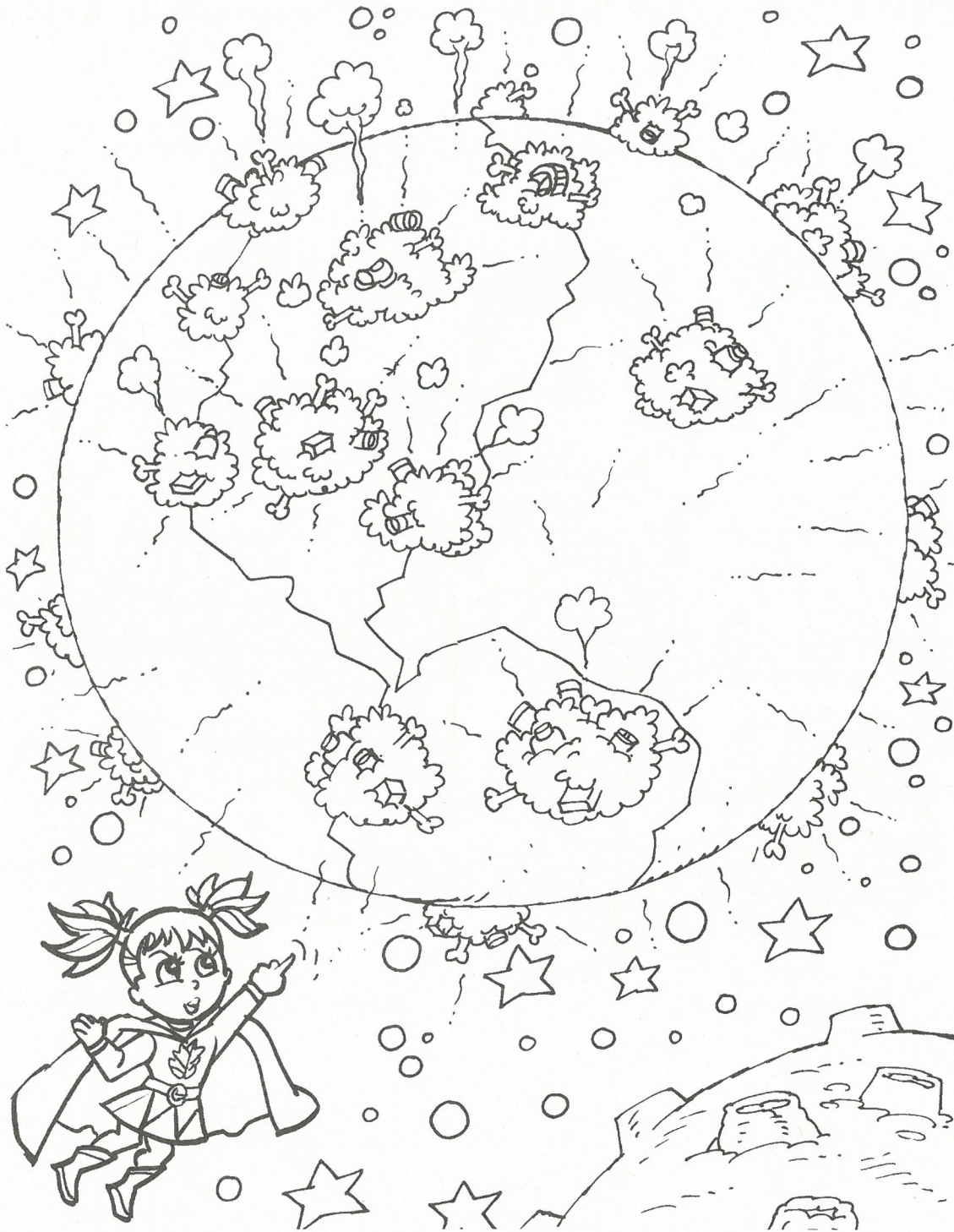

It's up to us Eco-Superheroes to do something every single day to save the planet.

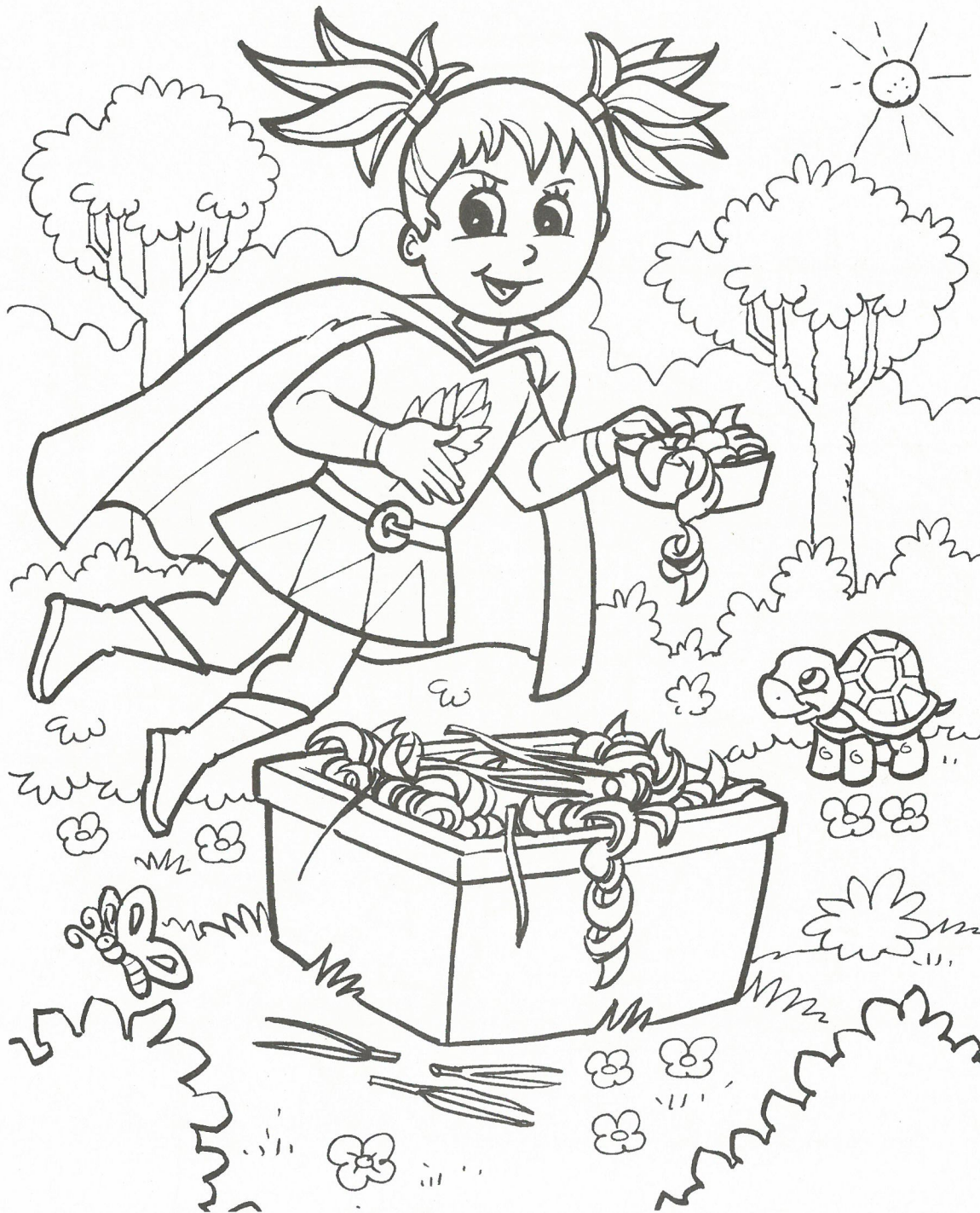
Go for the garden. How green is that!



Plant a tree. Grow some veggies. Start some flowers from seeds. And start a compost container to make your plants grow organically without chemical fertilizers.

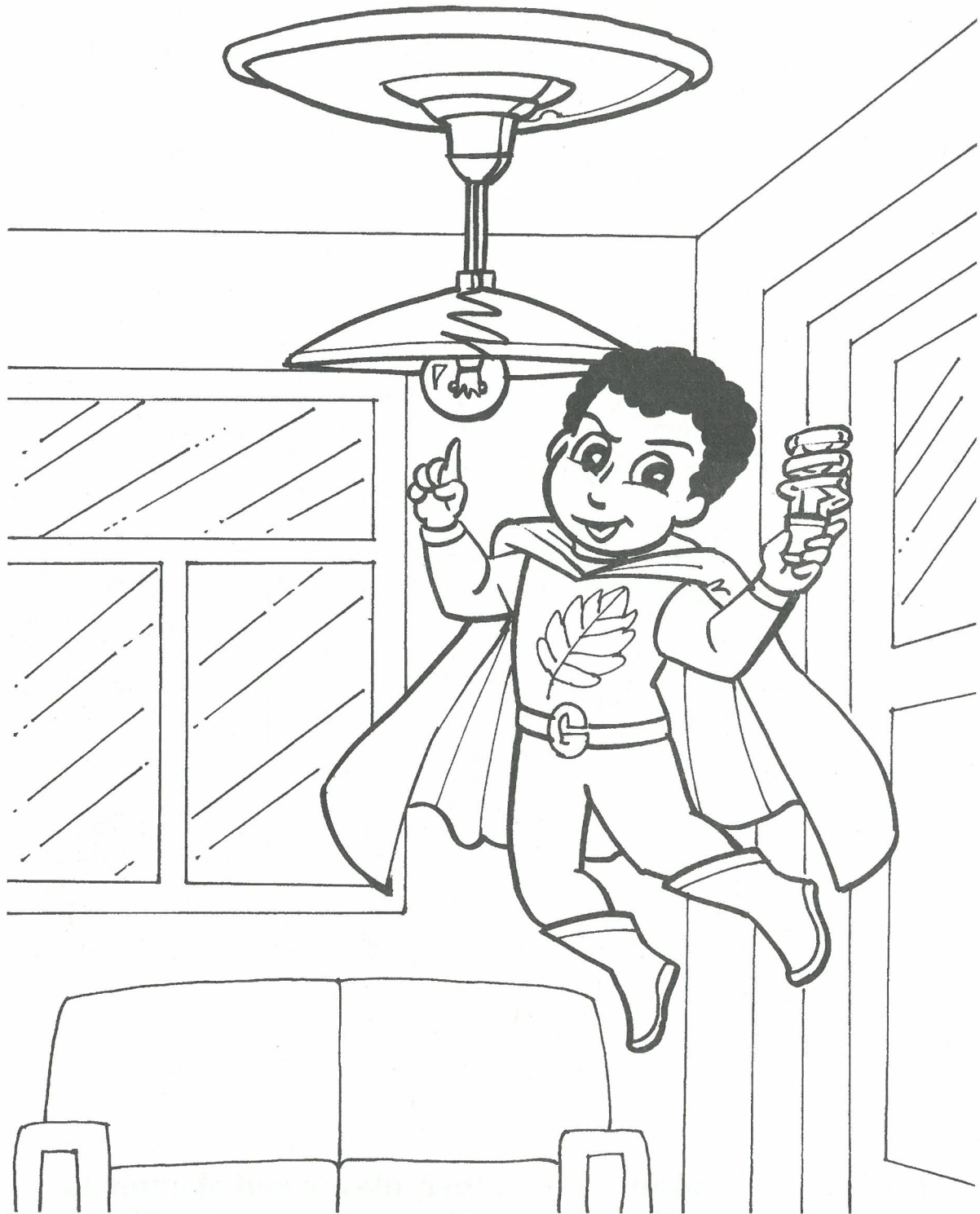
All you need to make compost is:

- **Organic like kitchen scraps**
- **Air for the bacteria to break down the scraps**
- **Water to break down scraps**



You can make compost from fruit peels, salad trimmings from lunch and broccoli stems and potato peels. Add pine needles or dry leaves, too. Plants LOVE to grow in compost.

Change the world by changing light bulbs to energy saving fluorescent bulbs. If everyone in the United States replaced even ONE light bulb – it would prevent 90 billion pounds of greenhouse gas emissions from power plants.



That's like taking 7.5 million cars off the road.

Want to be an Eco-Superhero? Start a recycling program at home, at school or in your community.



Make special containers for paper, plastic and aluminum. When they're full, take them to a local recycling center. They can be remade into something useful and they won't be tossed into a landfill.

Guess how long these things take to waste away?

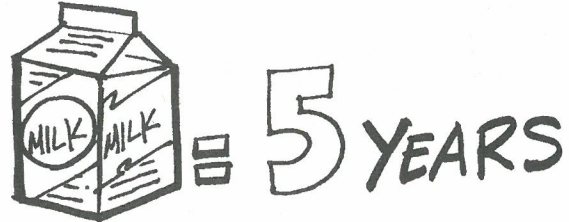

Reusing is similar to recycling. Use both sides of paper. Draw on grocery bags.

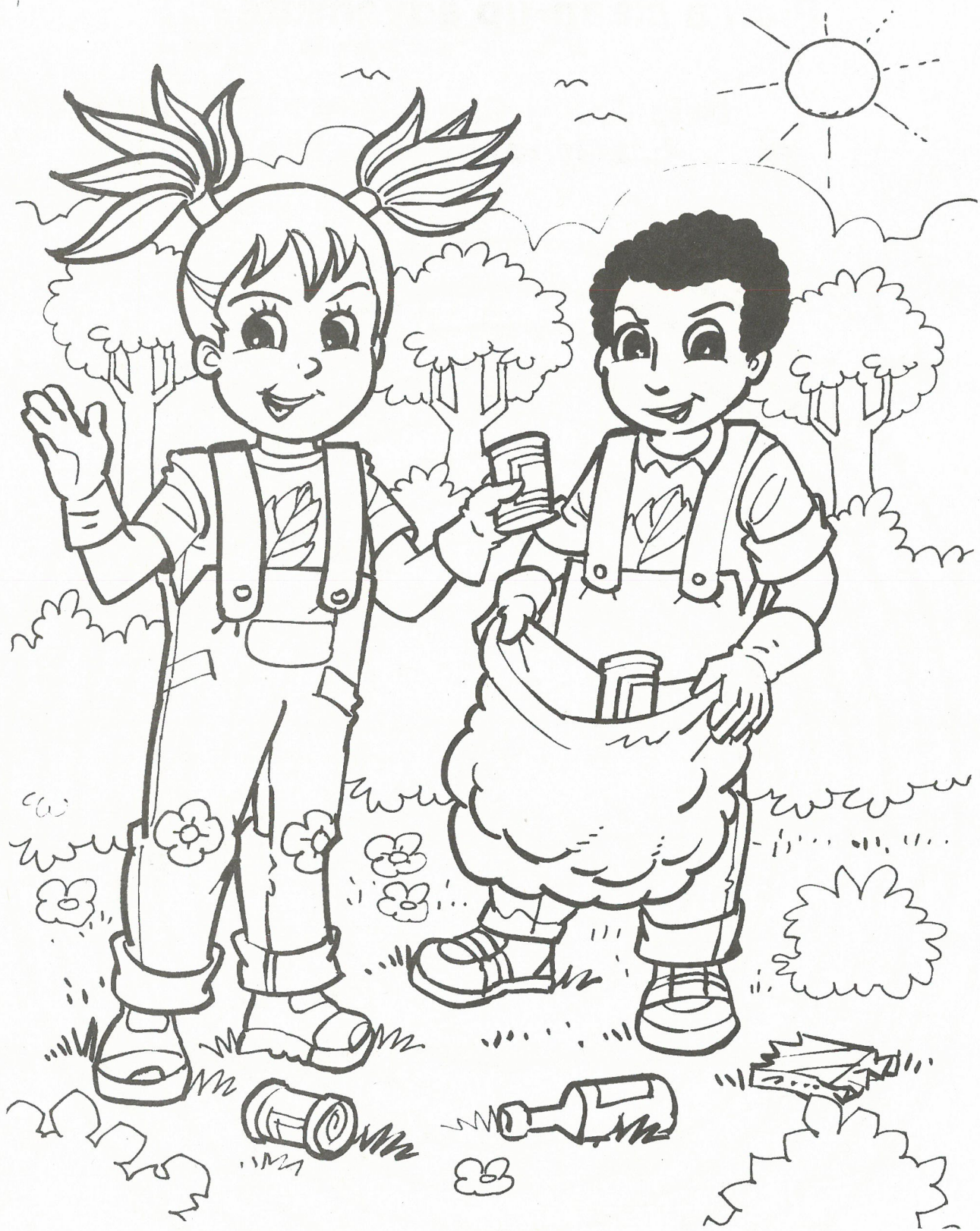


**Can you think of more ways to reuse? And reduce your use!

Plan a clean-up adventure.



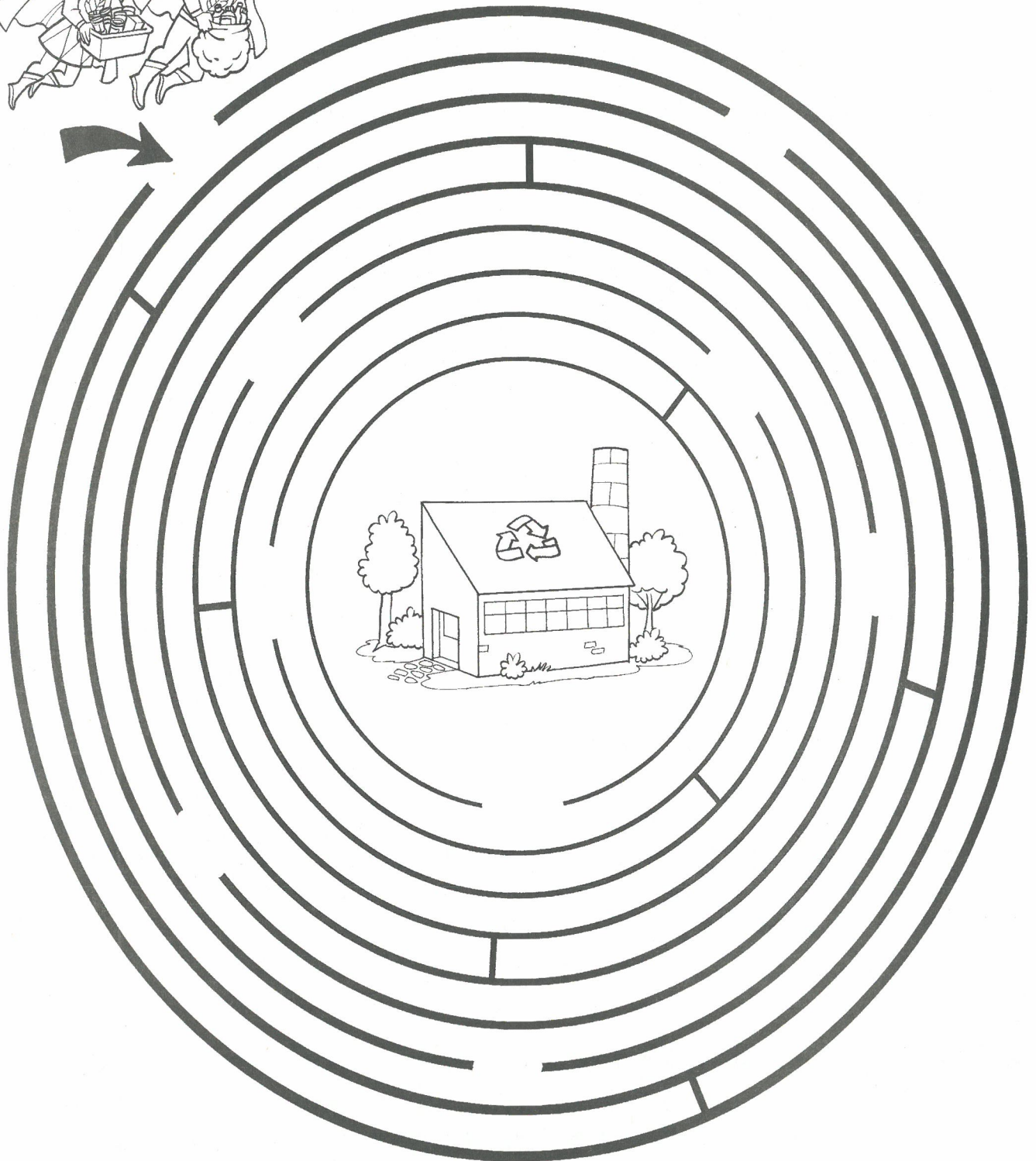
**Pick a park or a beach and pick up cans and trash.

You'll make the world a nicer place to live in.**



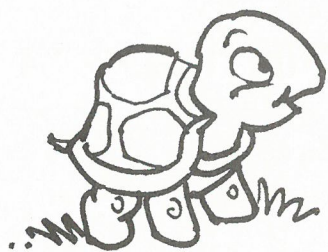
Being an Eco-Superhero doesn't mean you have to wear a cape or have super powers. It means that you care about our planet and are willing to do something about saving it.
